Genesis 4:1 *Now Adam knew Eve his wife, and she conceived and bore Cain, saying, "I have gotten a man with the help of the LORD."*

1. The Fall Of Hero: (Genesis 4) Gave (but not the best), Anger, Murder

2. Cain in 2020: Brothers, Worship, Response

Proverbs 17:17 *A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.*

Colossians 3:23 *Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,*

Ephesians 2:10 *For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.*

3. Final Thoughts: We Are CAIN!!!

2 Timothy 3:1-5 *But understand this, that in the last days there will come times of difficulty. For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, proud, arrogant, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, heartless, unappeasable, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not loving good, treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having the appearance of godliness, but denying its power. Avoid such people.*

1 John 1:8-10 *If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.*

1 Peter 2:24 *He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.*
